

Disciplinary Measures—Alleged Violation of Non-Academic Misconduct

In its consideration of appropriate discipline, a Hearing Panel may consider prior violations of the Honor Code and other misconduct by the student. The Student Conduct Coordinator shall provide the Hearing Panel with information concerning a student's prior conduct violations only after a determination of responsibility has been agreed upon by the Hearing Panel in the matter that is then before it.

Disciplinary measures that a Hearing Panel may impose include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Account Hold
- Community Service
- Degree Withholding
- Educational Programming
- Expulsion
- Graduation Clearance
- Honor Code Education
- Loss of Housing
- Loss of Participation Privileges
- Parental Notification
- Probation
- Restitution
- Revocation of Academic Credit
- Skills Remediation Sessions
- Social Probation
- Suspension
- Written Reprimand
- Campus Restrictions
